Decode a P-metric sidewall, plus speed-rating and load-index lookups. Never downgrade a speed rating, and match or exceed the load index on your door-jamb placard. Print at 100% scale.

What each part of a P-metric code means

PART	EX.	MEANING
Type	P	Passenger (LT = light truck)
Width	225	Tread width in mm
Aspect	65	Sidewall = 65% of width
Build	R	Radial construction
Rim	17	Wheel diameter (inches)
Load	91	Max load per tire (see table)
Speed	H	Max speed (see table)
